Regional Support Center (RSC)

The Division of Behavioral Health has designated Southeast Missouri Behavioral Health in Poplar Bluff as a Regional Support Center (RSC). We provide prevention services for Service Area 19 which includes the following six counties:

- Butler
- Reynolds
- Stoddard
- Carter
- Ripley
- Wayne

The RSC assists communities in their efforts to build and sustain resilient, drug-free communities. The RSC provides technical assistance, training and resources to community teams, task forces, coalitions in their efforts to promote a healthy, drug-free environment. Regional Support Center services include assistance in identifying community needs, encouragement of collaboration among organizations, education on developing plans of action. The RSC ensures communities stay up-to-date with state and national policies and goals as well as advocate for local policy change.



Law Enforcement offices in the Service Area reported collecting 1,042 pounds of unused or expired prescription medication this year for safe disposal during the National Take Back Day events in April and September and inside the Medication Drop Boxes that are permanently installed in their offices.

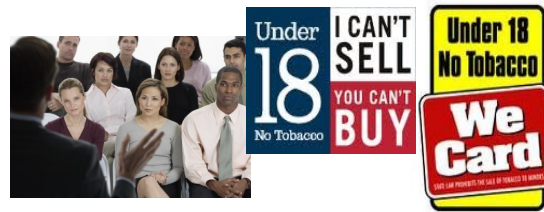
Education and Trainings Provided

- Tobacco Use by Minors Prevention Training

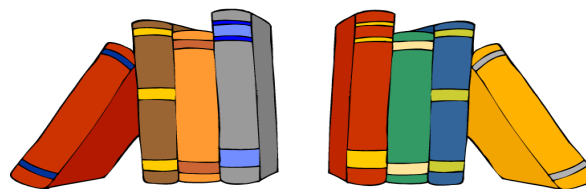
